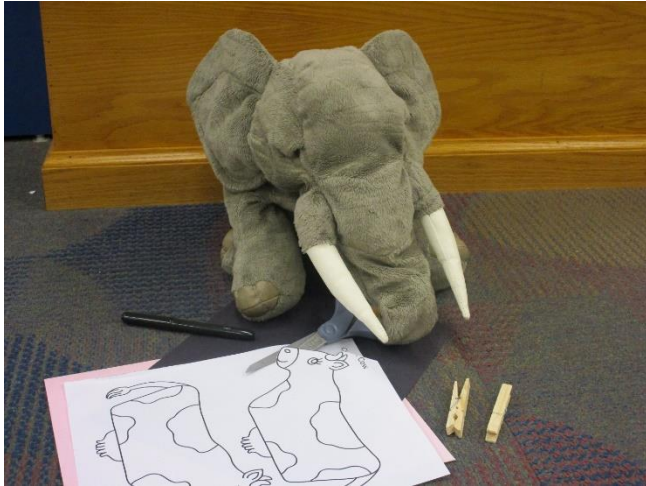
Books to Read Aloud:

The Craft:

This craft is a cow made out of paper and clothespins.

What you'll need:

- Black paper
- 1 cow cutout (provided in [this link](#))
- 1 piece of pink paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- 2 clothespins
- A marker

Instructions:

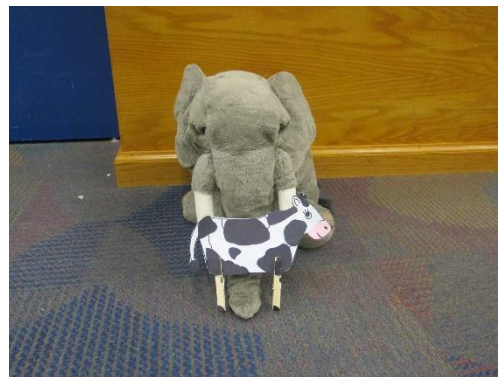
Cut out the cow cutout and then glue the two halves together so that the markings are facing inward.

Cut up the black paper to make spots and glue them to the cow.

Cut out a small oval of pink paper and glue to the cow's nose.

Use the marker to give your cow eyes and to color in the clothespins.

Attach the clothespins to the bottom of your cow to make the legs and you're all done.
